Privacy Policy

Friends of the Queensland Police Museum Inc. (FQPM) respects and protects the privacy of users of our website. This privacy policy tells you how we collect and use information.

The term "Personal Information" in this privacy policy means any information from which your identity is apparent or can be reasonably ascertained. We do not collect Personal Information about you when you visit our online service.

You can use this service without telling us who you are or revealing other Personal Information. If you contact us you do not need to identify yourself or use your real name.

Scope

The purpose of our website is to provide you with information about the FQPM, the Queensland Police Museum (QPM) and like-minded organisations.

Personal information

If you contact us we will collect the email address you nominate and any other identifying information you provide, such as a name or phone number.

If you apply for membership of the FQPM we will collect the information provided on your membership application form and store it in a secure environment.

Please do not give us other personal or sensitive information.

Other than circumstances such as unlawful activity, we do not share Personal Information with government agencies. We do not share your Personal Information with like-minded organisations. If you ask us about a like-minded organisation, we will provide you with the necessary details to make contact yourself. You may opt out of further contact from us at any time.

How we deal with complaints and requests

You may request access to Personal Information about you that we hold and you may ask us to correct your Personal Information if you find that it is not accurate, up-to-date or complete. You may also make a complaint about our handling of your Personal Information. These services are free of charge.

To protect your privacy and the privacy of others, we will need evidence of your identity before we can grant you access to information about you or change it.

You can contact us by email, or send your request or complaint to the email address or postal address listed on our website or below. We undertake to respond within 30 days. If the request or complaint will take longer to resolve, we will provide you with a date by which we expect to respond.

How we protect your Personal Information

We take reasonable steps to protect your Personal Information from misuse, interference and loss, and from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure. Our online service is hosted in Australia in a secure environment. To help protect the privacy of data and personal

information we collect and hold, we maintain physical, technical and administrative safeguards. We update and test our security technology on an ongoing basis.

We train our committee members about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the privacy and security of your information. Access to your Personal Information is restricted to executive committee members of the FQPM who need it to provide benefits or services to you.

Website analytics

To improve your experience on our site, we may use 'cookies'. Cookies are an industry standard and most major websites use them. A cookie is a small text file that our site may place on your computer as a tool to remember your preferences. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser however, please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of our website.

Our website contains links to other websites. Please be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. **When you go to other websites from our website, we advise you to be aware and read their privacy policy.**

Our website uses Google Analytics, a service which transmits website traffic data to Google servers in the United States. Google Analytics does not identify individual users or associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. We use reports provided by Google Analytics to help us understand website traffic and webpage usage.

By using our website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner described in Google's Privacy Policy and for the purposes set out above. You can opt out of Google Analytics if you disable or refuse the cookie, disable JavaScript, or use the opt-out service provided by Google.

FQPM also uses interfaces with social media sites such as Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter and others. If you choose to "like" or "share" information from our website through these services, you should review the privacy policy of that service. If you are a member of a social media site, the interfaces may allow the social media site to connect your visits to this site with other Personal Information.

Our obligations

We are obliged to use the Personal Information we do collect about you while protecting your privacy preferences and your personally identifiable information.
